CONDUCT OF BOARD MEMBERS DURING PUBLIC MEETINGS

All Board members shall have the right to address themselves to any matter on the floor at a public meeting. Such address shall be in a manner worthy of the office of Board member.

If, in the opinion of the President, a Board member is in violation of conduct becoming a Board member, the President shall rule that member out of order.

Any disagreement on the part of the Board member with the President's ruling shall afford said member the right to ask for a majority vote of the remaining Board members to either concur with or overrule the President's ruling.

If the Board overrules the President, the Board member in question shall continue, if he/she wishes, in the same vein.

If the Board concurs with the President, the Board member in question shall cease and desist.

If the Board member in question then continues in the same vein, they shall be reminded by the Board President that they have been ruled out of order by a majority vote of the Board.
